- Social context Liverpool in the 1960s, housing, social class, family structure and gender
- Historical context (time set and period written) Britain between 1950s and 1970s
- Cultural
- The theatrical conventions of the period in which Blood Brothers was created explore
 and identify the characteristics of Blood Brothers. Explain the impact they have on the
 text.
