

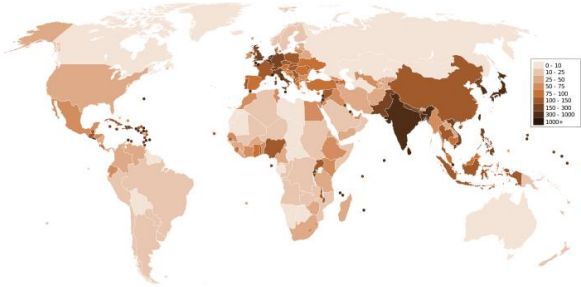

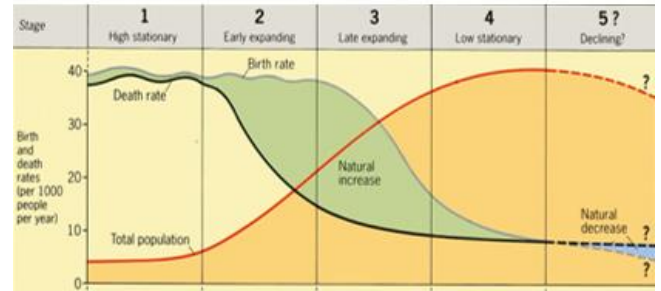

Task 1: Use the map to DESCRIBE how the world population is distributed (spread)



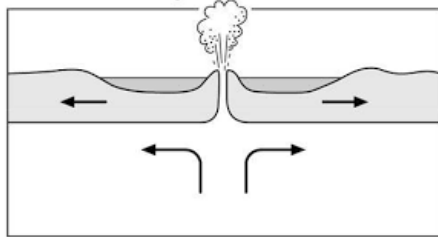
Task 2: Use the graph to EXPLAIN what happens at each stage of the Demographic Transition model



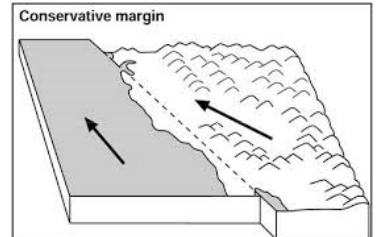
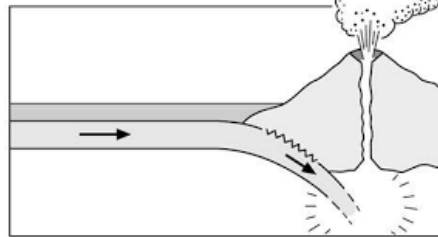
Task 3: Draw the three diagrams below out (including their names). Under each on EXPLAIN the process that is occurring and how it produces earthquakes / volcanoes

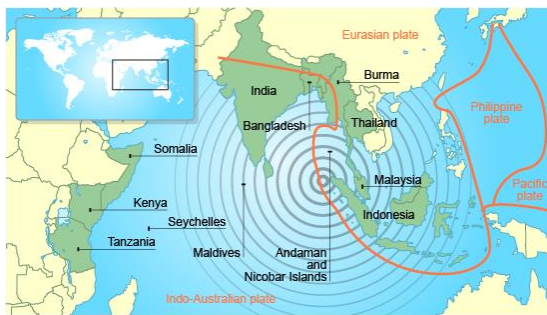
Constructive margin

Task 4: DISCUSS whether the immediate or long-term effects were the most dangerous



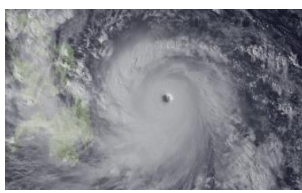
Task 5: Use the below information to answer the following question. 'The downfall of Thomas Cook had NOTHING to do with globalisation'
