Activities
Produce a set of top trumps about a topic of your choice. Your topic should allow you to make at least 20 cards. Choose a large topic that can have lots of items, and ways of describing them. Topics you could start with that need no research are; fast food (I have done an example on the next page), fruit and vegetables, cars, animals, holidays.
For each item, give it a rating for each of the five categories. Look at my example to see the type of categories you could use. Include a picture and make the cards as colourful as you can.
Once you have made the cards, try playing the game with someone in your house. Divide the cards between you. The youngest plays goes first. That player chooses a category and states the score. The other player shares the score for the same category. The person with the highest/best score wins both cards, and can choose the next category. Continue like this until one player has all the cards and is therefore the winner.
You can also choose a topic linked to work you are doing from school. For example kings and queens (History), countries (Geography), metals (Science).
Where do you complete the work?
Use paper or card that you have at home.
