Ir **To go**

Ir is a key irregular verb.

Voy	I go
Vas	You go
Va	He/she/it goes
Vamos	We go
Vais	You (plural) go
Van	They go

'A' 'Some' 'Many'

The words for 'a', 'some', 'many' change according to the gender of the noun and whether it is singular or plural

Un museo	a museum
Unos museos	some museums
Muchos museos	many/lots of museums

Una tienda	a shop
Unas tiendas	some shops
Muchas tiendas	many/lot of shops

The Near Future Tense

You use the near future tense to say what you are going to do. To form the near future tense, use the present tense of ir (to go) **a**, followed by the **infinitive**

¿Qué vas a hacer?

What are you going to do?

Voy a salir con amigos
Vas a ver la televisión
Va a ir de paseo
Vamos a jugar al voleibol
Vais a chatear
Van a hacer los deberes

I'm going to go out with my friends
You are going to watch the television
He/she is going to go for a walk
We are going to play volley ball
You are going to chat
They are going to do their homework

Using Two Tenses Together

To reach a higher level you need to show that you can use two tenses, for example the present tense and the near future.

Infinitive

Escuchar (to listen to)

Bailar (to dance)

Comer (to eat)

Jugar (to play)

Hacer (to do)

Ir (to go)

Present Tense

escucho (I listen to)

bailo (I dance)

como (I eat)

juego (I play)

hago (I do)

voy (I go)

Near Future Tense

Voy a escuchar (I am going to listen to)

Voy a bailar (I am going to dance)

Voy a comer (I am going to eat)

Voy a jugar (I am going to play)

Voy a hacer (I am going to do)
