



Measuring Our Impact

We measure the impact of our careers, guidance, and support using the eight Gatsby Benchmarks and the Compass Audit and Tracker from the Careers Enterprise Company. Annually students are tracked, and a destination report sent back to the local authority.

In 2023 we had 82.8% of our students move on to further education (decrease of 1.1% on 2022) and 5.2% went on to Apprenticeships and Training (increase of 1.9% on 2022). Our NEET figure (Not in Education Employment or Training) in 2023 was 9.9%.
