



Measuring Our Impact

We measure the impact of our careers, guidance, and support using the eight Gatsby Benchmarks and the Compass Audit and Tracker from the Careers Enterprise Company. Annually students are tracked, and a destination report sent back to the local authority.

At the end of the 2023-2024 academic year, we had 93.1% of our students move on to further education (increase of 6%) and 4.8% went on to Apprenticeships and Training (decrease of 0.3% on 2023). Our NEET figure (Not in Education Employment or Training) in 2024 was 2.7%; a decrease of 7.2% on the previous year
