Year 11 Apprenticeship Opportunities

Things for Parents to remember

- 1. Your child is a student with SWA until 30.06.2025.
- 2. Apprenticeships are advertised like regular jobs and come with deadlines. This must be checked before your child applies.
- 3. National and international employers will call their apprenticeships 'School Leaver Programme'.
- 4. Apprenticeship opportunities become more prevalent around late spring and early summer.
- 5. Your child must learn to travel. The perfect opportunity is not likely to be on your doorstep and your child will need to learn to use public transport if they don't already.
- 6. Is your child ready for the world of work? Are they mature enough to cope? Are they ready to work a 40-hour week? Do they know how to act around strangers? Will they take instruction without question? Doing an apprenticeship is a big ask for a 16-year-old
