Dear Parent/Carer,

Due to the forthcoming weather warnings and the potential disruption caused by snow, we are writing to remind you of the procedures and protocols we will follow should the school need to close for safety reasons, along with the associated contingency plans.

The safety of our pupils and staff is always our top priority. In the event of adverse weather conditions, a decision regarding school closure will be made as early as possible.

Should the school be required to close, students will be expected to engage with home learning activities set by their class teachers. This is supported through platforms such as **Sparx Maths, GCSE Pod and Satchel One**. Students will need to check these platforms regularly to access their activities. Students should follow their normal timetable, wherever possible, to help maintain routine and continuity of learning.

Communication with parents and carers during any period of closure will be delivered through the following channels.

- A message sent via **MCAS**
- An announcement on the **school website and social media platforms**

These platforms will be used to provide timely announcements, guidance on home learning and confirmation of reopening arrangements.

We kindly ask that parents and carers ensure their contact details are up to date on MCAS so that important notifications can be received promptly. Unless otherwise stated, if no communication has been sent, the school should be assumed to be open as normal.
