Dear Parents and Carers,

Further to Mr Friswell's letter sent on 5<sup>th</sup> May. I would like to further clarify information regarding year 11.

As you are aware, the GCSE examination period is now underway, with students sitting their English examination today. We would like to thank you for your continued support during this important time for our Year 11 students.

### **GCSE Examinations and Masterclasses:**

Students have been provided with a detailed examination and masterclass timetable. These masterclasses are being delivered by subject teachers to support students in preparation for their examinations.

Some sessions begin at 8:00am and continue throughout the school day. Please encourage your child to check the timetable carefully each day so they are fully aware of the sessions and examinations taking place.

Alongside attending school and intervention sessions, students should also be completing regular revision at home. We strongly encourage students to make full use of resources such as GCSE Pod, revision materials provided by teachers and past examination papers to support their preparation.

We would also like to remind all students that full school uniform must be worn for every examination. This includes:

- Blazer
- Black trousers/skirt (no leggings)
- Tie
- Appropriate school shoes (no trainers)

### **Final Examinations and Leavers' Assembly:**

The final examination for the majority of the Year 11 cohort will take place on the morning of **Monday 15th June 2026**.

Students studying Spanish will complete their final examination on **Tuesday 16th June 2026**.

The Year 11 Leavers' Assembly will take place on **Monday 15th June 2026 at 10:45am**, following the completion of the morning examination. During the assembly, subject awards will be presented to selected students.

Shirt signing will also take place at this time. Please note that students must attend their morning examination in a clean school shirt with no writing or signatures on it prior to the assembly.

Your child has also been sent a link by Mr Molloy to cast their votes for the Year 11 awards that will be presented during Prom. Please ensure they complete the questions on the form as soon as possible.
